## Vaccination schedule for Pet animals

## Points to be noted:

- 1. Animals should be in good health at the time of vaccination. Do not vaccinate animals which are already in stress.
- 2. Try to deworm animals & remove ecto-parasites one to two weeks prior to vaccination.
- 3. Strictly follow vaccination schedule after consultation with veterinary experts.
- 4. Keep records of vaccination.
- 5. Maintain cold chain for vaccines which may have to keep for 2-8 degree Celsius temperature.
- 6. Create stress free environment for animals after vaccination.
- 7. It is recommended to follow manufacturer's instructions.
